PRIVACY POLICY

It is Bakerview Conulting's / Barb Drozdowich's policy to respect your privacy regarding any information I may collect from you or which you may provide to me, in the circumstances set out below. 1) Personal Data I collect via my website (http://bakerviewconsulting.com) (the "Website")

Personal Data that you provide to me. I only collect Personal Data where you choose to interact with us on the Website in the following ways:

Data that I collect automatically

3) Sharing of your Personal Data

I share Personal Data as necessary with third parties who provide services or functions on my behalf and who require the information to provide those specific services to us. 6) Children

7) Access to and control over your Personal Data

I will only use your Personal Data for the purposes for which I collected it, unless I reasonably consider that I need to use it for another reason and that reason is compatible with the original purpose. If you wish to have an explanation as to how the processing for the new purpose is compatible with the original purpose, please contact me.

If I need to use your Personal Data for an unrelated purpose, I will notify you and I will explain the legal basis which allows us to do so.
